### NATURAL WONDERS



**EVERGLADES TOUR: ENDS AT MIA AIRPORT (Code: MIA01D)**

 **Duration**  
4 h



See one of Florida's natural wonders - the Everglades wetlands - before your flight out of Miami on this excursion, lasting around four hours. You'll take an airboat ride for an up-close view of the area's flora and fauna (with the potential to spot wildlife) and have some free time before a transfer directly to Miami International Airport.

**Read more**

Those flying out of Miami can pack in a final adventure to their trip with this excursion of approximately four hours to the Everglades, with a direct airport transfer at the end of the trip for convenience. Recognised as both the largest subtropical wilderness in the United States and a UNESCO World Heritage site, the Everglades sits at the far southern tip of Florida. Learn more about this unique region at the Everglades Holiday Park, reached after a narrated drive of approximately one hour from the port.

Once arrived, you'll have around two hours at the park, including an airboat ride of approximately 30 minutes. As you glide over the water in the airboat, take in the mix of mangrove forests, swamps and marshes surrounding you and see if you can spot any wildlife, which could include some of the area's 350-plus bird species (such as egrets and hawks) or even the Everglades' most famous residents: alligators.

After the airboat ride, you can use the remainder of the time to further explore the Everglades Holiday Park and browse the venue's gift shop for souvenirs, before a transfer of approximately one hour to Miami International Airport.

**Important Information:** Please note: this tour is intended for guests disembarking from Miami who are booked on a flight from Miami International Airport departing after 14:30 hours/2:30 pm for domestic flights or after 15:30 hours/3:30 pm for international flights. Guests using a wheelchair who wish to participate are required requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk 48 hours prior to the tour. Guests disembarking in Miami who wish to book and prepay the tour are required to use code MIA01D. Please expect some queues at the venue. The alligator show that is presented at the Everglades park is on a time-permitting basis and may not be feasible in consideration of onsite waiting times and guests flights departure times. During the airboat ride, wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed given that it is a natural habitat. Ear plugs can be purchased at the Everglades Park for an additional charge. Due to local regulations, regardless of flight departure time, guests will be requested to leave the ship upon arrival in port. Depending on the flight schedule, guests with evening departures may be dropped off at the airport a few hours earlier than the typical 2-3 hour window before their flight. This could result in an extended wait at the airport; therefore, we recommend planning accordingly. In the event that minimum number of guests required for the tour to operate is not met, guests traveling in transit and those disembarking may travel on the same bus. The order of drop-off will be determined by local traffic conditions and tour itinerary. If necessary, a stop at the airport may be made prior to returning the transit guests back to the pier.

**EVERGLADES TOUR - IN TRANSIT (Code: MIA01T)**

Explore the Everglades wetlands by airboat ride during this excursion of around four hours. As you glide over the water, keep an eye out for alligators, birds and other native wildlife. You'll also have some free time at an activities park with other Everglades experiences.

**Read more**

Nature lovers will enjoy seeing the Everglades up-close from an airboat on this excursion of approximately four hours. Home to a wide range of wildlife, this vast wetlands area is known as the largest subtropical wilderness in the United States and has been recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979.

Following a transfer of about one hour from the port, arrive at the Everglades Holiday Park for a stay of approximately two hours. During this time, you'll take an airboat trip into the wetlands, lasting around 30 minutes. This unique region contains ancient mangroves, wild alligators and an array of birdlife (including storks, hawks and herons), so keep your camera at the ready to snap pictures along the way.

As well as the airboat ride, you'll also be able to use the remaining time at the Everglades Holiday Park to enjoy other activities and Everglades experiences, as well as browsing the gift shop. Finally, a transfer of around one hour returns you to the port.

**Important Information:** Please expect some queues at the venue. The alligator show that is presented at the Everglades park is on a time-permitting basis and may not be feasible in consideration of onsite waiting times. During the airboat ride, wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed given that it is a natural habitat. Ear plugs can be purchased at the Everglades Park for an additional charge. In the event that minimum number of guests required for the tour to operate is not met, guests traveling in transit and those disembarking may travel on the same bus. **MIAMI CITY TOUR (Code: MIA02T)**



Spend the day exploring Miami with a sightseeing tour. This five-hour excursion includes a guided coach ride past major city landmarks and time to shop at Bayside Marketplace.

This five-hour combination tour and airport transfer is designed to help you make the most of the end of your vacation, featuring highlights of Miami.

You'll board a bus at the port for a roughly 3-hour sightseeing drive through Miami Beach's South Beach area, famous for Ocean Drive and its Art Deco buildings.

The route continues through central Miami, passing key streets and sites, before heading to Little Havana. From the bus, you'll see Miami's lively Cuban neighborhood, including the well-known Calle Ocho, then arrive at Bayside Marketplace—an open-air shopping center that often appeared in the 1980s TV show Miami Vice.

You'll have about one hour and 20 minutes at Bayside Marketplace to shop, grab lunch, or relax. Afterward, there's a 40-minute transfer back to the port.

**DOLPHIN MALL SHOPPING TOUR AND CITY GLIMPSE (Code: MIA03T)**



Make the most of your last day of vacation with this approximately five-hour excursion. The itinerary features a sightseeing drive through Miami, shopping time at Dolphin Mall, and a transfer back to the cruise port.

**Read more**

Board your vehicle at the port and set off on a guided coach tour, which lasts about two hours. You'll pass some of the city's major landmarks and travel through Miami Beach - this vibrant area hosts the North American edition of the world-famous Art Basel art fair, and it also features the largest collection of Art Deco buildings in the United States, located throughout the Art Deco Historic District.

After the guided tour, you'll head to Dolphin Mall, a popular shopping center with more than 240 stores and over 25 dining options. Enjoy around two hours and fifteen minutes at the mall to shop, dine, relax, or spend your time as you wish. Afterwards, you'll reboard your vehicle for an approximately 45-minute ride to the pier.

**Important Information:** In case the minimum number of guests required for the tour is not met, both transit guests and those disembarking may travel on the same bus. The drop-off order will depend on local traffic and the tour schedule. If needed, a stop at the airport may be included before returning transit guests to the pier.

### HOP ON HOP OFF MIAMI CITY TOUR-FOR IN TRANSIT GUESTS (Code: MIA04T)

Explore Miami on your own terms during this excursion, which gives guests access to a hop-on, hop-off tour bus. Spend as long as you like visiting key city sights on the tour route, including famous spots like the Design District, Little Havana and Miami Beach's South Beach neighbourhood.

**Read more**

Miami's open-topped hop-on, hop-off buses are an easy and ultimately flexible way to see the city. This excursion provides transfers to and from the port, as well as an all-day tour bus pass, providing access to landmark Miami sights and districts.

Following an approximately 30-minute transfer shuttle from the port to the Big Bus Tours Miami Information Center, board the next available bus and begin your tour. You'll be enjoying the sights of the Red Loop, and a full circuit of the loop takes approximately two hours and 10 minutes, with buses arriving around every 30-to-60 minutes. Stay onboard for the whole route and treat yourself to a driving tour, viewing the city from your seat, or hop off and on at any of the stops throughout the city for some independent exploration.

Those stops include Miami Beach's ever-energetic South Beach area (where the seven-mile boardwalk is constantly a hub for city life) and Art Deco Historic District, which houses hundreds of striking Art Deco buildings and was added to the prestigious National Register of Historic Place in 1979. Little Havana - known as Miami's Cuban district - is another popular stop. Make sure to visit Calle Ocho, one of Little Havana's main streets, to see the neighbourhood at its most atmospheric.

Once you're ready to head back to the ship, return to the bus station on one of the tour buses and take an approximately 30-minute shuttle ride back to the port (shuttle buses run once an hour on the hour from 1pm to 4pm). If time permits, there's also the option to spend some time at Bayside Marketplace (a shopping and entertainment complex with multiple eateries) before catching your shuttle transfer.

**Important Information:** Please note: this tour is only available for guests who are in transit in the port of Miami. Return transport to the cruise terminal will be via shuttle bus, which departs from Miami's Big Bus Central Station every hour on the hour from 1pm to 4pm.

### HOP ON HOP OFF MIAMI CITY TOUR - FOR DISEMBARKING GUESTS (Code: MIA05D)

Before you fly out of Miami, use your morning to embark on a bus tour that puts you in control of sightseeing. After viewing or visiting some of the most famous areas in both Miami and neighbouring Miami Beach, you'll be free to make your own way to the airport from downtown Miami. Luggage storage is included.

**Read more**

Map out a memorable final morning of your trip by enjoying some of the most popular sights of Miami and Miami Beach on this flexible excursion. You'll be taking a 'hop-on, hop-off' bus around the city and can even store your luggage at the bus station during your tour, before arranging your own journey to the airport.

A transfer drive from the port of around 30 minutes takes you to the Big Bus Tours Miami Information Center, where you'll board one of its hop-on, hop-off buses and begin a sightseeing tour on the 'red loop' route. This circuit covers some of Miami's best-loved spots, and the good news is you can get off and explore at as many or as few stops as you like.

Stops on the red loop include Bayside Marketplace, a waterfront shopping and dining complex where you can tuck into everything from Italian-style gelato to classic pizzas and refreshing daiquiris; South Beach (located in Miami Beach - a barrier island that's connected to mainland Miami), with its famous seven-mile boardwalk; the Miami Design District, packed with eye-catching art installations, contemporary galleries and hip boutiques; and Little Havana, a hub of Cuban-American life that houses restaurants, bars with live music, colourful murals and tucked-away Máximo Gómez Park, nicknamed 'Domino Park' due to locals' fondness for playing dominoes there.

When you're done exploring, continue the loop by rejoining another hop-on, hop-off bus - buses arrive at each stop every 30 minutes. Another option is simply to stay on the same bus for the whole loop and enjoy a sightseeing drive of the city.

Once you've had your fill of sights, return to the Big Bus Tours Miami Information Center, retrieve your luggage and independently make your way to the airport in plenty of time for your flight (the excursion does not include a transfer to the airport or transport costs).

**Important Information:** Please note: this tour is available (1) for guests booked on flights departing from Miami International Airport after 3:30 pm to destinations within the USA or after 4 pm to international destinations, (2) for guests booked on flights departing from Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport after 4 pm to destinations within the USA or after 4.30 pm to international destinations and (3) for guests with a reservation at a local hotel for an extended stay. This tour ends at Central Station at Bayside Marketplace. Transportation to the airport is not included. There are many Taxis or Ubers available to take you to your hotel, airport, or destination of your choice.

Get an insight into what South Florida has to offer on this approximately eight-hour excursion for guests flying out of Miami. The itinerary includes a visit to the Everglades (complete with an airboat ride), a sightseeing coach tour of Miami and shopping time at Bayside Marketplace, before transferring to the airport.

#### Read more

This approximately eight-hour excursion highlights South Florida's mix of natural beauty and urban life. Following a bus ride of around one hour, arrive at the Everglades Holiday Park for a visit of approximately two hours. The coastal mangroves, pine flatwoods and sawgrass marshes of the Everglades - designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1979 - are home to myriad species of wildlife, including the American alligator and the endangered leatherback turtle. You'll get a chance to try and spot some of the flora and fauna during a 30-minute airboat ride at the park, and there's also time to explore the park's other attractions, too. After departing the park, you'll take a coach-bound sightseeing tour of around one and a half hours, passing Miami Beach's Art Deco District, the lively Cuban neighbourhood of Little Havana and the colourful murals of Wynwood Walls.

Then you'll drive for about 30 minutes to Bayside Marketplace, finishing with approximately 90 minutes of free time, which can be used for shopping or perhaps to purchase lunch (at an additional cost). Finally, a transfer of approximately 30 minutes transports you to Miami International Airport.

After a bus ride of about one hour, you'll arrive at Everglades Holiday Park for a visit lasting around two hours. The Everglades, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1979, feature coastal mangroves, pine flatwoods, and sawgrass marshes, and are home to a variety of wildlife including the American alligator and the endangered leatherback turtle. During your visit, you'll take a 30-minute airboat ride through the park to look for local plant and animal life, with additional time to explore other park attractions. After leaving the park, you'll proceed on a coach sightseeing tour of about one and a half hours, passing through Miami Beach's Art Deco District, the vibrant Cuban area of Little Havana, and the colorful murals at Wynwood Walls.

Next, you'll drive around 30 minutes to Bayside Marketplace, where you'll have approximately 90 minutes of free time to shop or, if you wish, purchase lunch at your own expense. Finally, you'll transfer for about 30 minutes to the port.

PROTECTOURS: OCEAN DRIVE AND LINCOLN ROAD ART DECO WALKING TOUR - IN TRANSIT (Code: MIA13T)



Duration 3.5 h



Explore the Art Deco buildings of Miami Beach's South Beach neighborhood on this excursion, which lasts about three and a half hours. Take a guided walking tour to see the famous hotels along Ocean Drive, walk the beach boardwalk, and visit Lincoln Road.

Read more

Guests flying out of Miami can spend a morning exploring one of Miami Beach's most visually striking areas - South Beach and its extensive collection of Art Deco buildings - on this approximately three-and-a-half-hour excursion.

Miami Beach's Art Deco Historic District in South Beach has the largest concentration of Art Deco buildings in the United States and has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1979. On a guided walk that begins at Ocean Drive after a transfer from the port (about 30 minutes), you'll see and learn about some of these colorful structures.

Once at Ocean Drive, spend about an hour walking with your guide to view the Art Deco buildings and stroll the famous, seven-mile-long Miami Beach Boardwalk—a lively spot full of local energy.

You'll pass notable Art Deco hotels like The Gabriel South Beach (formerly Park Central Hotel from the 1930s), the Beacon South Beach, the Colony (from 1935, known for its tall neon sign), and the Cardozo South Beach. You'll also see Villa Casa Casuarina, the former home of fashion designer Gianni Versace, previously known as Versace Mansion.

The next part of the tour gives you about an hour to explore Lincoln Road nearby. This pedestrian shopping street dates to 1912, when real-estate developer Carl Fisher first cleared the mangrove forest to create it. In the 1950s, architect Morris Lapidus (who designed several notable hotels in Miami) redesigned the area into the Lincoln Road you see today. As you walk, keep an eye out for public art, which sometimes decorates the street. The tour ends with a transfer back to the port.

**Important information:** Guests are recommended to wear comfortable walking shoes. This tour involves a significant amount of walking—about one mile on flat terrain. If the minimum number of guests for the tour is not met, guests in transit and those disembarking may share the same bus. Drop-off order will be determined by local traffic and the tour plan. If needed, there may be a stop at the airport before returning transit guests to the pier.

Soak up Miami's sights from an open-top double-decker bus on this flexible, morning-based excursion for guests flying from the city. The tour can last however long you like (before catching a 1pm bus) and lets guests choose their itinerary from famous stops including South Beach, the Design District and Little Havana, before transferring to Miami International Airport. Luggage storage is included.

**Read more**

If you're flying out from Miami, use time before the flight to view the city's key attractions on this morning excursion that fits around your schedule. You'll be sightseeing via a hop-on, hop-off bus that stops at some of Miami's most popular areas, before a transfer takes you directly to Miami International Airport. There's even luggage storage to make things convenient.

Begin with a transfer from the port of around 30 minutes, which takes guests to the Big Bus Tours Miami Information Center. Here, you'll be able to use luggage storage facilities and join a double-decker bus tour with stops throughout the city. Buses at each stop arrive every 30 minutes or so and a full loop takes approximately two hours and 10 minutes.

Once onboard the bus, it's entirely up to you where to stop off and explore and when to rejoin the sightseeing loop on another bus. Alternatively, you can stay on one bus for the whole loop and soak up Miami from the comfort of your seat.

Stops include buzzing South Beach (known for its equally buzzy boardwalk - which stretches for seven miles and offers fantastic ocean views - and its Art Deco Historic District, which houses the largest concentration of Art Deco-styled buildings in the United States), the Miami Design District (full of museums, galleries, boutiques and colourful murals) and Little Havana (the city's hub of Cuban-American culture - take a walk along Calle Ocho and enjoy the many coffee shops, bars and restaurants, as well as the live music you might hear).
